### Set / Crowd Production Assistant

I worked both as a crowd and set production assistant on the film, Empire of Light directed by Sam Mendes and starring Olivia Coleman and Colin Firth. As a set PA my jobs included, making sure all cast were fed at an appropriate time and also walking them back and forth from their trailers whilst they were taking a break. Secondly, locking off the set when filming commenced and making sure all crew members knew when this was happening.

The second part of my job was working with the crowd on some days. This included meeting the supporting actors when they arrived for their fittings and makeup and making sure everyone had eaten and was ready in time for when they were needed on set. Once everyone was on set it was then my job to make sure the crowd all knew what was required of them in the scene and making sure everyone was in their first positions ready to film at the correct time.

### Production Assistant (Reality TV)

I worked as a production assistant on the American reality cooking competition show, Top Chef, for its 20th season which was shot in London. As a production assistant I was responsible for a number of jobs. Firstly, I was used as a stand-in for when the camera crew were setting up shots before the contestants arrived on set.

Secondly, I was someone who was responsible for loading the equipment in and out of the Luton vans once we arrived on set and was then tasked with making sure it was all put up correctly in the right places.

Lastly, I was also a driver on this job which meant driving a van to the cast hotel where interviews with the cast would take place and picking up the camera crew and driving them and their equipment to the next location. I also had a day where I was tasked with transporting a camera crew around as they shot B-roll.

### Location Marshal

I worked on a number of TV shows as a location marshal, these include the Danny Boyle directed TV series, Pistol, the BBC show, Back to Life and the Amazon Prime series, The Lord of the Rings: The Rings of Power. My duties included stopping cars and pedestrians whilst filming is happening, helping with the on-set catering by giving food and drinks to other crew members.

Whilst working on Pistol, I also did a week work of prep. In this week I visited each of the filming locations early and helped the locations team set up all costuming and makeup rooms, figure out a one-way system around set to comply with the COVID rules, and do letter drops to all the surrounding residents.
