I have flew everything from the basic mini right through to the DJI fly cart and other things such as filming octocopters were you attach the cameras to the gimbals right through to the new inspire 3, which has been approved by Netflix to be used for drone filming. I have flew in BVLOS and the normal VLOS and i have flew in very very complex operations and very tight spaces with drones.

The qualifications that i have are A2 COFC, GVC, Fixed wing and i am looking at getting my UK Sora qualifications. Outside of the UK i have completed the EASA qualification (European drone licence), IAA qualification (Irish drone licence) and i am looking into the part 107 FAA qualification (American licence) , however this one is a little bit more complicated to get but i am working on it. I am also licenced/ experienced to get permissions for flying in the isle of man using a CAA form 4 from the isle of man government. This is only for commercial filming/other work, but hobbyist drone flying you do not need any licences or permissions for that in the isle of man. I am also a expert in FPV flying.

I am fully upto date with every regulation and rules of the CAA.

I currently manage a small client base and do everything from doing various small shots such as business promotional stuff right through to large client work, however i am more looking at getting into production companies to use my services.

I have excel experience with a whole variety of office packages. I am also experienced in editing using a range of adobe pro suites and i am taking a course to become a adobe certified expert editor, but this will take time.

I have 26 years experience overall in flying a range of remote aircrafts.

I have worked on high end filming for various clients, one for example was for a private martial arts film in which i was the FPV pilot and aerial pilot for some fantastic shots. This was a Indian martial arts film that was filmed in London but shown in India, aswell as being the editor for this, i was also the drone pilot and FPV pilot. We do at least 3 knocks on the properties to try and get this sorted for them. If we cannot get this resolved then the second thing we do and its a very last resort is obtain rights of entry warrants from the magistrates courts and then execute the warrant with a locksmith and engineer and sometimes dog handlers and other agencies if needs be to gain access to the meter and either exchange it for a credit meter or smart meter if its residential or to disconnect the meter if its a business address/account. I have to plan these visits in a timely manner for the clients and to get the best possible outcome for the clients but also the best outcome for the Customers/debtors also to help them if I can to stop getting within the same situation again.

Sometimes this wouldn't work so then we would then go down to forced pre pay or forced disconnection route with a magistrates warrant so my role would then be to act as warrant officer and to attend addresses with the warrant with a team of people i.e. Engineers, Dog handlers, Locksmiths, Roller shutter engineers etc etc and then to force fit or force disconnect the meters by entering under a rights of entry warrant to the property and then dealing with it on the day for the clients whether this be Residential or commercial properties. I also was revenue protection officer also so dealing with gas and electric thefts so we would go out and assess the site and if there was any abstraction then i would deal with this by way of disconnecting (Commercial) or or fitting a pre pay meter if residential but then if the same customer done it twice more then so 3 strikes and your out then we would disconnect the supply to the residential property under health and safety grounds.

I have done various things such as security, Bailiff work, High Court enforcement work for many many years and i have also done Utility warrants for debt and revenue protection investigation visits and disconnections for different agencies the most years of doing i was with Face 2 face contact when they used to have the commercial debt work with British gas. 20 years experience doing debt recovery

and enforcement of various orders as well as 15 years almost doing Door security work with many years working as head door/Head of security managing teams of door supervisors.

I have also been a hobbyist uav pilot for 26 years and then went commercial 4 years ago. I have my GVC, A2 and fixed wing qualifications. When the CAA releases the new training for the 1 - 4 remote training i will be doing this aswell. I have done FPV and other things. I have flown all the parrot drones including the parrot disco FPV fixed wing, i have flown remote helicopters, remote planes i have pretty much flew everything i could get my hands on ranging from the weight 249 payload all the way to 25 payload. I already had my A2 through Infratec drone training but this was done about 4 years ago.

I am currently in the process of looking at getting my part 107 FAA licence, and i have my EU licence and my IAA Irish drone licence.
