## PROFILE

I am a passionate filmmaker and camera operator who finished University in May 2024. Since then I have been working as a freelance camera operator for a company called FilmMyMatch. Working with this company has allowed me to film at big stadiums such as Wembley, Emirates, Amex and many more. I recently covered the England mens international games against Latvia and Albania I have also been working on some promotional content for small businesses in my local area. I am a passionate cinephile and football fan who prioritises spending time with my friends and family when I am not working. I am a great timekeeper and communicator who gives their all to everything they work on. I am currently available on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday with a minimum two week notice.

## EXPERIENCE

### FilmMyMatch - Camera Operator - September 2024 - Present

- This role involves filming tactical footage for all levels of women's football from academy games to the Women's Super league. The footage is used by the teams analysts. I will supply them a live feed of the game either at the gantry or the dugout using a Limit 8 Kit.
- In this role I also film RFU rugby championship games and the RFU Premiership cup games. This is filmed with a wide angle and a tight angle camera simultaneously. This is also for the analysts which I will provide feeds for using either HDMI or SDI cables.

### Nandos - Waiter - February 2022 - February 2024

- I worked at Nandos as a waiter whilst at university in Brighton. Within my role as a waiter, I looked after the customers to make sure they had the best possible dining experience. I did this by being polite and offering my services. I also learned how to operate a till and communicate with customers in busy hours.
- After about six months of working at Nandos I was promoted to the position of Buddy where I had to train new members of staff and be a role model to all new and current staff members.
- In March of 2023 I was promoted to Supervisor. Within this role I had to manage shifts to ensure they ran smoothly. I also had to deal with complaints from customers and look after the wellbeing of my colleagues on and off shifts.

### M.B. Tree Care - Groundsman - June 2019 - January 2024

- I worked part time for MB Tree Care whilst attending college and university. My role was to help my two colleagues by clearing the tree debris and keeping the site clean and tidy, trimming Hedges, filling chainsaws with fuel and using the wood chipper. This has taught me to speak with customers and take instructions from my work colleagues and keeping to health and safety standards.

### Sparks Gifts - Warehouse/Office Assistant - October 2018 - May 2019

- I worked part time at Sparks Gifts, this was initially a Christmas job in their warehouse, but they asked if I would be able to continue to help them. I started off by putting stock on the shelves ready for picking and packed customer orders and updated their computer system with dispatched delivery details. I then started working in the office updating their website with the goods they are selling as well as designing some of the website.
