

# Theresa Varga, Director

Theresa Varga is an award-winning director from the North of England. Drawing from the art of surrealism, Theresa's work uses colour and framing as a way to heighten the comedy and characters within a story, as well as searching for the realism within the heart of the drama.

Achievements to date include directorial pieces shortlisted for the Underwire Festival, BFI Future Film Festival and Tri-force at BAFTA, as well as the acclaimed Smalls Festival and LOCO Film Fest. Winner of IdeasTap Film Showcase in association with BAFTA 2015, best young director at Short to the Point Film Festival in July 2016 and winner of IdeasTap Graduate Award- Short Film.

"Bossman", a short about an intergalactic fried chicken shop, won best short film at the Cannabis Culture Film Fest in NYC and best short film at the Around Films International Film Fest.

Most recent 2018 collaborations have seen work with award winning web series "Reality 2.0", festival short "Clean As You Like" by Masked Pony Productions and series 3 of BAFTA winning CBBC comedy "Secret Life of Boys".

"The universe", a TV series written by Theresa Varga and Nathan Bryon, was recently shortlisted for the Edinburgh TV Debbie Awards - Test Card Pilot Award.
